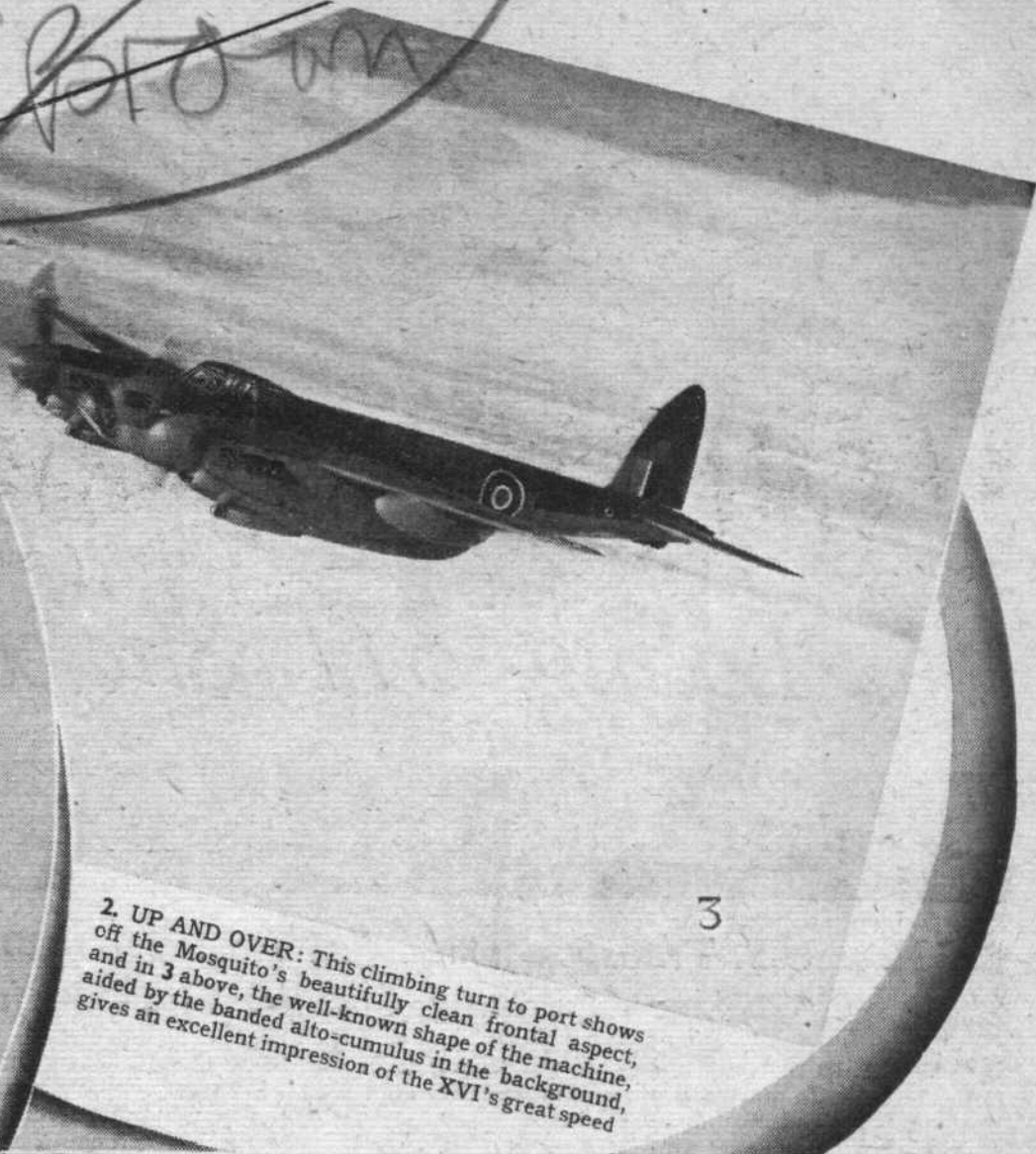
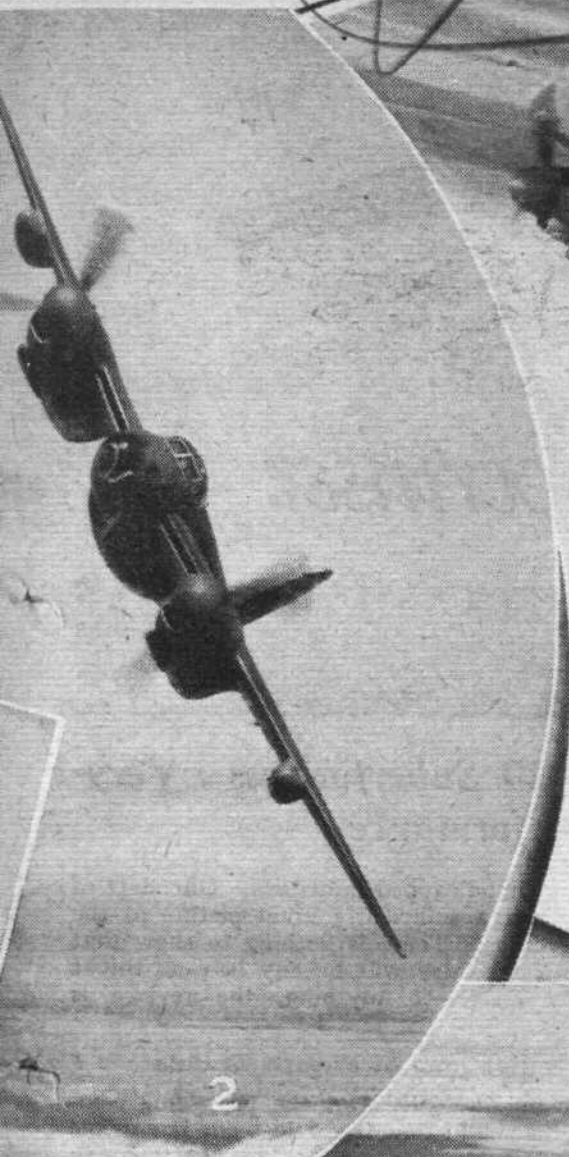

2. UP AND OVER: This climbing turn to port shows off the Mosquito's beautifully clean frontal aspect, and in 3 above, the well-known shape of the machine, aided by the banded alto-cumulus in the background, gives an excellent impression of the XVI's great speed

4. PLAN VIEW ; Here we can see the projection of the oil and coolant radiator intakes in the centre - section leading edge, a location which is highly efficient both from the aspects of both from the aspects of aerocooling and of aerodynamic drag. Also can be seen the doors of the bomb-bay which bulge out from the normal fuselage contour.

5. WHO GOES HOME ? Bomb gone and course set for base, a Mk XVI flashes home in the icy air, its lovely shape silhouetted against the sun.
