



FIRE FIGHTING UNIT

This unit is a foam-making aircraft fire fighting vehicle mounted to the Bedford "R" type 4 x 4 156" wheelbase fire appliance chassis/cab fitted with twin rear tyres under Vauxhall Bedford chassis code No. 91.

The unit incorporates a Dennis No. 2 pump unit complete with ancillary equipment. Also incorporated in this fire fighting unit is a heat exchanger foam compound tank, searchlight, electric fire bell, two Pyrene FB10X foam-making branch pipes and necessary hose equipment.

The tanker is completely shrouded in aluminium and incorporates six storage lockers, each fitted with special nylon running gear with aluminium roller shutters.

The main tank unit is mounted on special Vibro insulators.

Vehicle is finish painted and signwritten to the authorities' specification.
