Description Major regional carrier in southern Australia, carrying an average of more than 19,000 passengers every week on almost 1,000 flights.

History Known as Premier Aviation until 1971, when the name was changed to Kendell Airlines. In 1986 Kendell virtually doubled its network overnight when it took over the South Australian routes of the Ansett-owned Airlines of South Australia. Services to Burnie, Tasmania, were introduced in 1989, after a pilots' dispute (which did not affect Kendell) and were subsequently extended to Devonport. The airline expanded partly through the acquisition of routes and services from Ansett Australia which, after deregulation of the domestic trunk routes in 1990, has been unable to cross-subsidise unviable regional and country services. Further route expansion began in November 1999 when Ansett reduced its Tasmanian operations.
