History Formally constituted in 1927 and began operations with a service between Madrid and Barcelona with King Alfonso XIII as a passenger on the inaugural flight. Until 1939 Iberia remained a domestic airline when it became international airline with a regular service between Madrid and Lisbon. It was nationalised in 1944, and in 1946 became the first airline to fly between Europe and South America. Joined the Oneworld alliance on 1 September 1999.
