



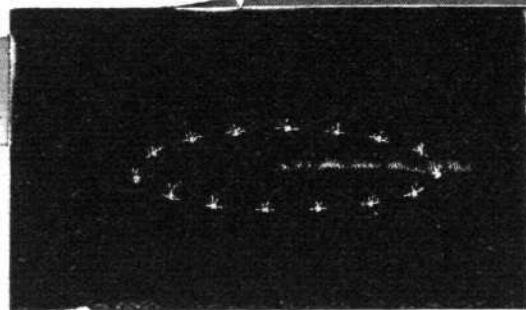

It shows pilots the direction and strength of wind by day or night. Placed where the eye sees it best—at the centre of the aerodrome circle—it emits a steady plume of dense white smoke which can be switched on or off from the control tower. At night, coloured lights shining upwards alternate automatically with horizontal white lights showing the smoke—forming a distinctive landmark in themselves.
