"The Call is Answered"

Seaplane Tender 441 (engines 6SM Diesel 40743, 40738) went to the rescue of a Lancaster aircrew adrift in a dinghy off the S.W. coast. A Mosquito sighted the crew boarding their dinghy and stayed circling it until relieved by other aircraft of the Air Sea Rescue Service. The crew used Verrey lights and torch to signal their position, and the tender was able to locate them and pick them up successfully.
