

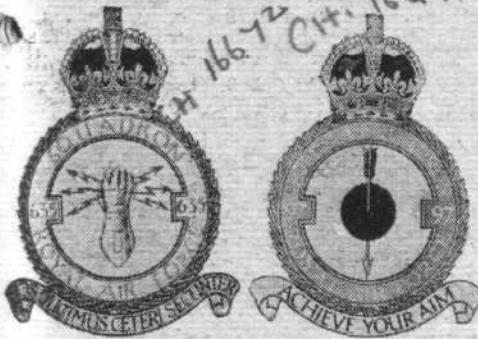

RAINBOW PRECURSOR: The Republic XF-12, shown here in prototype form, was originally designed for long-range photographic reconnaissance work in the Pacific theatre of operations.
