EMERY

International freight company Emery Worldwide has appointed **Frederic Schnitzler** to the newly created position of logistics manager for Europe, based at Charles de Gaulle Airport, Paris, France. JAL

Akiro Kondo, Japan Airlines' (JAL) senior managing director responsible for corporate planning, will be JAL's next president, subject to shareholder approval at the annual general meeting to be held on 29 June. He will succeed **Matsuo Toshimitsu**, who will remain on the board as an advisor. **Akiro Kohno**, managing director for domestic passenger marketing, will become executive vice-president. Kondo, who joined JAL in 1957, was elected to the board in 1989, as was Kohno, who joined in 1958.

USAF

Air Force Lt Gen **Joe Ralston**, US Air Force deputy chief of staff for plans and operations, is to succeed Gen **John Michael Loh** as Air Combat Command chief at Langley AFB, Virginia. Air Force Maj Gen **Ralph Eberhart**, director of force

structure, resources and assessment for the Pentagon's joint staff, will be promoted to replace Ralston. Air Force Lt Gen **John Fairfield**, vice-commander of Pacific Air Forces at Hickam AFB, Hawaii, has been nominated to become deputy chief of staff for command, control, communications and computers, succeeding Lt Gen **Carl O'Berry**, who is to retire. Maj Gen **Eugene Santarelli**, director of operations at Pacific Air Forces, is to replace Fairfield. Gen **Charles Boyd** is to retire as deputy commander-in-chief of US European Command in Vaihingen, Germany. His replacement has yet to be named.

HEXCEL

Aerospace-composites specialist Hexcel, of Pleasanton, California, has elected **Marshall Geller** and **Peter Langerman** interim co-chairmen of the board. The appointments last until either the completion of a previously announced rights offering or the appointment of a new chief executive to replace **John Lee**, who continues as a director and consultant.
