#### No 6 Air Experience Flight, RAF Benson, Wallingford, Oxon

An Air Experience Flight Commander is required to provide air experience primarily for cadets in the Air Training Corps and the combined Cadet Force (RAF), using the Bulldog T MK1 aircraft.

You must be a flying instructor with broad experience as Service Qualified Flying Instructors or civilian equivalent, who has given airborne instructions in general handling, formation, flying, instrument flying and navigation. The minimum experience required is 500 flying hours in command and a background of supervising and managing a flying organisation.

If successful you will be appointed as a Senior Instructional Officer in the Civil Service, and also commissioned into the Royal Air Force Reserve. You would be required to wear the appropriate RAF Reserve uniform. Training will be provided and some pre-employment training may be required depending on your experience. You will also be required to pass a medical to ensure that you are fit to fly.

The working week is Wednesday to Sunday, although it may change during the Summer and Easter Camp Periods.

**SALARY:** The starting salary is £19,235 rising to a maximum of £24,059. All increases are performance related.

**HOURS AND LEAVE:** The normal working week is 42 hours gross and the annual leave allowance is 25 days with possible acceleration to 30 days after 5 years service for candidates with previous military service.

This is a Non-Reserved post and is therefore open to UK, British Commonwealth, Irish and European Economic Area nationals. Candidates should normally have been resident in the UK for at least the last five years.
