Cathay Pacific Airways Recruitment Ban

In July 2001, Cathay Pacific Airways dismissed 51 pilots following the commencement of Limited Industrial Action by the Hong Kong Aircrew Officers Association (HKAOA). No reason was given for the terminations. In consequence, the International Federation of Air Line Pilots' Association (IFALPA) instituted a Recruitment Ban on Cathay Pacific Airways Ltd., VETA Ltd., and USAB Ltd. The HKAOA and the management of Cathay Pacific Airways Ltd remain in dispute over this issue.

All professional pilots are reminded that they should not accept employment offers with these companies whilst the Recruitment Ban remains in force.

The Hong Kong Aircrew Officers Association (HKAOA) will support the applications of pilots respecting the Ban once a settlement is reached. If you have already deferred an employment offer or would like notification when the Ban is lifted, please register with the HKAOA at:
